Faculty of Philosophy, University of Novi Sad is pleased to announce the call for applications for its Doctoral Studies. **The information below is aimed at foreign students who would like to pursue their doctoral studies at the Faculty of Philosophy, University of Novi Sad.**

REQUIREMENTS

Eligible to enrol:

- Candidates with both bachelor's and master's degree in total of 300 ECTS credits in the field which is the same or similar to the programme they want to enrol in; the average grade must be higher than 8.00 (according to the grading system at Serbian universities) for both levels of study.

- **Exceptionally**, candidates that have obtained 300 ECTS but their average grade is lower than 8.00 can enrol if they have a minimum of five scientific papers published in selected professional peer-reviewed journals – national or international.

SPECIAL/ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT

- It is expected that doctoral students speak at least one international language actively (speaking, writing, and reading - at B2 level), and to know one more language – at B1 level. The proficiency test for the first language (B2) is to be completed by the end of the first semester; in case the student does not meet the test requirements, the testing is expected to be completed by the end of the second year. The proficiency test for the second language (B1) is to be done in the fifth semester or not later than the sixth. The testing is conducted by the Centre for languages at the Faculty of Philosophy and the candidates will be notified about the testing upon enrolment. The cost of the tests is in accordance with the Centre's price list.
If a candidate already holds an internationally recognized certificate of language proficiency, the testing is not mandatory.

IMPORTANT DATES

APPLICATION

- **Submission of applications:** 17, 18 and 19 October 2018 (from 9 am to 1 pm)
- **Interview with the applicants will take place on 23 October 2018.**
- **The preliminary rankings will be published on 24 October 2018, by 3 pm at the latest.**
- The appeals can be lodged on 26 October 2018, from 9 am to 12 noon.
- **The final rankings will be published on 29 October 2018, by 3 pm.**

ENROLMENT of accepted students

- **30 and 31 October and 1 November 2018 – from 9 am to 1 pm.**

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

The full application should consist of

1. **Application folder** (available at the Faculty's book shop);
2. **Diploma/degree** obtained at the undergraduate level, together with diploma supplement and transcript of records;
3. **Diploma/degree** obtained at the master's level, together with diploma supplement and transcript of records (It is necessary that the diploma/degree be verified by the University of Novi Sad prior to application. If the procedure is not finished, when applying the students can submit a confirmation that the procedure is in progress. The verification has to be completed in order for the student to enrol);

4. Copy of the **ID card** or the **passport**;
5. Short **biobibliography**, focusing on the professional and academic achievements;
6. **Proof of Serbian language** proficiency or of the language of instruction for the appropriate programme. The proficiency of Serbian is tested at the Centre for Serbian as a Foreign Language at the Faculty, <http://www.srpski-strani.com/>. The testing fee is 9,000.00 RSD;
7. **Proof of proficiency of another foreign language**, at least on B2 level;
8. **Application fee payment form** (payable at the bank or the post office). The application fee is 20,000.00 RSD;

ENROLMENT DOCUMENTS

Documents to be submitted upon enrolment:

1. **two ŠV-20 forms** (available at the Faculty's book shop);
2. **student's ID booklet** (has to be bought at the Faculty's book shop. Please present the payment slip. The payment for the ID booklet should be pre-done, at a bank or a post office, to the bank account number 840-1712666-26, ID booklet cost: 700.00 RSD);
3. **two photographs** (format 4.5 x 3.5 cm);
4. proof that the student has **health insurance** for the whole academic year;
5. **tuition fee payment form** (tuition fees can be paid in four instalments);
6. **enrolment fee payment form** (payable at the bank or the post office). The enrolment fee is 20,000.00 RSD.
