

NOVI SAD

Novi Sad on the banks of the Danube, just oppsite Petrovaradin Fortress (the Gibraltar of the Danube) is a city of diverse and rich cultural heritage of the Serbs and many other nations. The city itself is the centre of Serbian culture and creativity with Matica Srpska as the oldest Serbian institution of culture and science.

Novi Sad is a vibrant city despite the fact that it relies heavily on the tangible and intangible cultural heritage of centuries past. It is a modern university city, the cultural, tourist, scientific, political and administrative centre of the Autonomous Province of Vojvodina. It is the city of museums, galleries, theatres, festivals, rich alternative stages and the European Capital of Culture 2022.





SOMBOR

The long tradition in education was established in Sombor in 1778, when the school "Norma" was founded and the first courses in teacher training for Serbian teachers were introduced. After it was closed in 1811, the first Teachers' Academy (the Preparandium) was founded in Szentendre (today's Hungary), which was later (1816) moved to Sombor. Today, this is the Faculty of Education.






SUBOTICA

In the north of Vojvodina, alongside the main European corridors and two rivers, the Danube and Tisa, lies the city of Subotica, one of the significant European cities of the Secession period, with rich cultural, architectural and educational heritage.

It is a city of rich educational heritage. The State Teachers' Training School was established in Subotica in 1871, which became the Pedagogical Academy after the Second World War. Today, it hosts the Facučty of Economics, the Faculty of Civil Engineering and the Teacher Training Faculty in Hungarian.





ZRENJANIN


Zrenjanin is a town in the west of Vojvodina, in the Serbian part of the Banat region, and it represents its political, trade, cultural and sports centre. It has around 75 thousand inhabitants who are of over 20 different ethnic origins.

Today it is known as a multicultural and multiconfessional town that prides itself on its interethnic tolerance and cultural heritage. It is oriented towards culture, arts and sports. It hosts the "Mihajlo Pupin" Technical Faculty.




Number of study programmes per type and level of studies (academic year 2022/2023)


Number of study programmes per UNS unit (academic year 2022/2023)





UNS AWARDED THE ERASMUS CHARTER FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

- The European Commission adopted a decision on awarding the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) to the University of Novi Sad, after a successful evaluation of the application by the University of Novi Sad, submitted on March 20th, 2018.
- In the latest procedure on awarding the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education, the European Commission has adopted a decision on awarding the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education 2021-2027 to the University of Novi Sad for the next seven-year period.
- The Erasmus Charter describes the basic principles that each higher education institution should respect when applying for project funding, or when carrying out the project activities, in the framework of the whole Erasmus+ programme of the European Commission.
