LANGUAGES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES IN CONTACT: THE CHALLENGES OF INTERDISCIPLINARITY

on the 5th of October 2024

at the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad

The main aim of the conference is to contribute to the scientific discussion on interdisciplinarity and collaboration between sciences. Although the name of the conference implies the connection between languages and social sciences, papers that tackle interdisciplinarity within different social or linguistic fields are welcome as well. We especially encourage papers that would contribute to this philosophical, theoretical and methodological discussion in an original way, by reflecting on the related issues, as well as those that deal with specific social or ethical issues or topics pointing to the necessity of an interdisciplinary approach. Papers that consider methodological, theoretical and metatheoretical dimensions of these areas, papers that approach certain phenomena in an interdisciplinary way and those that tackle challenges and possibilities in higher education related to this topic are invited.

We hope that you will accept the call and kindly ask you to send an abstract belonging to one (though not exclusively) of the following areas:

The conference will be held live, in English, Serbian and all the official languages of former Yugoslavia. The presentations will last for 20 minutes. The conference fee will not be charged.

Instructions for writing an abstract

Abstracts should contain the following elements:

1. An author's (and a co-author's) name
2. An author's (and a co-author's) affiliation
3. An author's (and a co-author's) email
4. An abstract title - up to 15 words
5. A clear description of aims, methods and expected results of research - between 180 and 250 words
6. Key words - up to 10 words

Abstracts in English, Serbian, or one of the official languages of former Yugoslavia should be submitted via email as a word attachment to the following address interdisciplinarnost.konf@ff.uns.ac.rs until June 1st.

Notification of acceptance will be sent until June 30th. The conference programme and the book of abstracts will be published by the end of September.

Conference proceedings will be published in an electronic collection of papers. Deadline for paper submission is November 30th, and the collection of papers will be tentatively published during 2025.
